Summarize Results of Milestone:

This milestone focused primarily on the implementation documentation as well as the test case documents and performance documents. Because the user manual had already been completed, it was not necessary to do any work on that objective. Small changes were made in the SAUSAGE program to include saving and loading matches to and from a hard or floppy disk as well as error checking to keep users from loading invalid matches in which the team specified does not exist.

Strengths of Milestone:

The main program has come together very nice and the user manual for the SAUSAGE application is extremely useful. The manual discusses in great detail how to operate the software as well as how to install and setup the application and database. No database administration skills are necessary to operate the SAUSAGE program.

Weaknesses of Milestone:

The major weakness of this milestone was not fixing all bugs within the software. Obviously it is unrealistic to get out every single bug within the application, but a few known bugs do remain. These include attempting to export a match to the database when that match already exists as well as a few other match data errors.
